ENLISTED ASSOCIATION OF THE NATIONAL GUARD OF TENNESSEE AUXILIARY (Guidelines)

The EANGTN Auxiliary has established a scholarship program. If funds are available, one scholarship in the amount of \$500.00 will be awarded to the number one ranked applicant. An alternate recipient will be selected in case the recipient is unable to accept the award. No previous recipients may apply again. Non-recipients may reapply as long as stated requirements are met.

Please read all materials carefully before submitting application. The following persons are eligible:

- 1) EANGTN Auxiliary Members.
- 2) Applicants must be high school senior, enrolled in a university, college, business or trade school.
- 3) Dependent children/step children up to age 26 of EANGTN Auxiliary Members.

The applicant must have shown traits and qualities of leadership by having participated in school and/or civic activities, demonstrated strong motivation for continued higher education, and an indication of a need for financial support.

There shall be no consideration whatsoever given for friendship, rank or grade of applicant, applicant's parents, or applicant's spouse.

Awards will be sent directly to the recipient's choice of accredited school when verification of current enrollment is received by the committee chairperson. If the school term is not completed, due to cause other than sickness or injury, the school will refund the unused portion of the scholarship award to the EANGTN Auxiliary.

Graduate students are not eligible.

All applications will be accompanied by:

- 1) A transcript of high school credits or transcript of college credits for applicants already in institutions of higher learning.
- 2) A letter from applicant with personal specific facts as to his/her desire to continue his/her educations and why financial assistance is required.
- 3) Letter of recommendation verifying the applications and giving general moral and personal traits
- 4) One (1) letter of academic reference (should be Principal, Counselor, Dean or Professor).
- 5) A photograph of applicant.
- 6) A photocopy of current EANGTN Auxiliary Membership card.

Each scholarship application to be considered by the EANGTN Committee must be mailed to Lolita Horton. If there are any questions, she can be reached at: mljac2002@yahoo.com. Packets must be postmarked no later than 15 days prior to the start of conference each year to be considered. The Auxiliary would like for the recipient to attend the state conference. If recipient is unable to attend the conference, the sponsor can receive the award on the recipient's behalf.
