To improve the position and status of the enlisted members in their relationship with the civilian community as well as in a military environment.


To develop and promote legislation designed to obtain these purposes.

The 2020 National Defense Authorization Act: National Guard Highlights

- A 3.1% Pay Raise
- TRS for Mil Techs (Effective 2030)
- 12304b early retirement credit is retroactive to 2012
- GI Bill transferability will no longer have a maximum years of service limit
- Military student identifier for RC children
- Repeal SBP/DIC offset by 2023
- Paid family leave for federal employees
- Establish US Space Force with a JCS seat
- Single standard record of service (the DD214) will include Guard and Reserve service
- No involuntary ANG Mil Tech conversions to AGR
- No subjective upgrades to USR
- Report on incentives for AGR/Mil Tech
- Report on paying BAH vs OHA in territories
- Plan on phase out of burn pit usage

EANGTN ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- TN STRONG Act, allowing all TN Guard Members the opportunity to obtain a Bachelor's degree and was later expanded to cover certifications and Master's degrees
- National Guard members' protection under the Federal Tort Claims Act
- · Unlimited commissary access for Guard and Reserve
- · Incapacitations pay for member of National Guard traveling to and from training locations
- · Survivor Benefit Program (SBP) improvements
- · Technical supplemental annuity for retirement prior to age 62
- • SGLI expansion from \$35,000 to \$50,000 to \$100,000 to \$200,000 to \$250,000 to \$400,000
- · Elimination of discrimination in hiring because of National Guard and Reserve
- · GI Bill for the National Guard and Reserve
- VA Home Loan for Guard and Reserve
- · Gray Area Retirement Benefits
- Increases in the Montgomery GI Bill
- Medical care for injured Reservists
- · Improved Veterans' Reemployment Rights
- Improvements in the Soldiers and Sailors Civil Relief Act
- Increase in retirement points raised from 60 to 130 per year

Membership

- TN is ranked 2nd in the Nation for Membership!
- Types of membership:
 - Annual members of the National Guard and retirees, dues are paid every year
 - <u>Life</u> members of National Guard and retirees, onetime fee payment for life
 - Associate individuals who aren't members of the National Guard, dues are paid every year
 - <u>Associate Life</u> lifetime membership for associates
 - Corporate Bronze, Silver, Gold, Platinum, and Platinum Plus membership levels
 - Honorary bestowed by EANGUS leaders

Membership

- Membership for both organizations are included in the same payment.
- So, when you join EANGTN, you're joining EANGUS, as well!
- It is quicker & easier for TN to process membership when payments are made through the state level.

EANGTN/EANGUS Membership Dues

Enlisted Annual Dues E1 – E6 = \$17

Enlisted Annual Dues E7 - E9 = \$42

Associate Annual Dues \$24

Membership is based on an anniversary year. For example, if you renew your membership on 15 June of this year, your membership will not expire until 15 June of next year.

LIFE MEMBERSHIP - One-time fee of \$210

Auxiliary Membership: Annual - \$15.00 Associate - \$6.00

ASSOCIATE LIFE MEMBERSHIP – One-time fee of \$150 EANGUS Associate Life Membership - One-time fee of \$110
